A maximum of two entries will be permitted per competition entrant.

Photos should be submitted in JPEG format and should not exceed 2mb in their compressed storage.

Submitted images should not have been taken more than 2 years before the closing date of 27.06.2008.

Any images that may have previously won a prize in a national competition, or international competition or that have been used for commercial purposes will not be eligible for entry, to ensure that no breach of third party copyright will be encountered.

All Entrants agree to participate in any publicity in connection with this competition.

Image Editing

You may use limited image enhancement and manipulation to optimize an entry into the competition, but you must not use this to falsely add or remove significant elements.

Closing Date for Entries

The closing date for receipt of all competition entries through the Culham Publications Website will be 27.06.2008. Entries received after this date will not be accepted and deemed void.

Judging

A group panel from the organisers, Culham Publications Services will judge the competition entries after the closing date to select an overall Winner. The Judges decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

The Winner will be emailed no later than 14.07.2008 to arrange suitable timescale for the Prize to be awarded.

Copyright

The entrant should be the sole author and owner of the copyright for the submitted image. It is therefore the Legal responsibility of the entrant and not the organisers to ensure that they comply with these ownership and copyright requirements and own the rights to reproduce their images. Any entries that do not in the opinion of the organisers fulfil this criteria will be deemed ineligible and disqualified.
